Neillsville Farmer's Market Rules for 2022

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of the Neillsville Farmers' Market is to provide an outlet for sales of locally grown fresh produce. Through the Farmers' Market, a local economic stimulus is intended by providing local produce growers, direct marketers of other agricultural products, and local crafts people an outlet to sell their products. The market also provides a location for residents and visitors to get fresh produce and local crafts. The presence of this market will also support the WIC and Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program.
- **2. Location**: The Sniteman Town Square at the corner of Hewett Street and Fifth Street in Neillsville.
- **3. Date and Time**: Saturday mornings from 8:00 a.m. until noon starting the first week in June through the end of October. Sales will not begin prior to 8:00 a.m. and set up will not begin prior to 7:30 a.m.
- **4. Products**: Local & homegrown fresh fruits and vegetables, certified nursery stock, non-retailed goods, jellies, processed specialty foods, meats, cheeses, and handmade crafts. Vendors must abide by the 80/20 rule where 80% of the goods they sell are homemade or grown. The other 20% may be seasonal items they purchased for resale to fill the Vendors' product line. Flea market and garage sale type items will not be sold.
- **5. Liability Insurance**: Vendors will carry liability insurance to cover their Farmers' Market activities.
- **6.** Licensing and or certification: Vendors selling processed foods and nursery stock will provide the Market Manager with documentation of required Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection licensing and/or certification.
- **7. Cleaning Up**: Vendors will clean up after themselves at the end of their sales period including any waste that may be left behind by animals.
- **8. Charitable Organizations**: Charitable organizations such as youth groups may participate in bake sale and cookout-type events provided they schedule a day with the Market Manager.
- 9. Location-Location will be moved on October 8th to the parking lot behind Library in order for Autumn Harvest Festival to take place at Sniteman Town Square.

By signing this document, Vendor agrees to abide by these rules. Violation of these rules can result in penalties up to and including Vendor termination with the Market.
