
2023 Neillsville Garbage and Recycling Service Map Please refer to the map below to determine your collection day

- Bulk waste collection must be scheduled at least 48 hours prior to pickup. To schedule a bulky pickup, please call (888) 271-7176.



Garbage Collection Guidelines

- Residents of Neillsville receive weekly curbside trash collection. Please see the map in this brochure to confirm your pickup day.
- Place your containers at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day or the night before.

Yard waste, brush, branches and Christmas trees will be collected curbside by the City periodically throughout the year. Refer to the City of Neillsville website at **Neillsville-wi.com/public-works** for more information.

Residents may also drop off yard waste, brush, branches and Christmas trees at the City compost site located at 800 West 8th Street during daylight hours.

Items accepted for compost are:

- Leaves
- · Grass clippings
- Garden waste
- · Brush and branches

Please do NOT deposit any sticks, twigs or branches in the compost.

State law requires the following materials be recycled but they are not acceptable at the curb. Please visit dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/recycling to determine where they can be recycled.

- Motor Oil
- Batteries
- Appliances
- Tires
