DISPOSAL OF LEAVES, BRANCHES AND YARD WASTE

Yard Waste, Brush, Branches and Christmas Trees

These items will be collected curbside by the City periodically throughout the year, contingent upon work schedule and manpower.

In May of each year, the City designates a week for spring clean-up of yard and garden waste. The City will pick up these items if bagged and left on the boulevard. Fall clean-up dates will be announced on the rolling news, on the City's Facebook page, and in the Clark County Press.

Resident may also drop off yard waste, brush, branches and Christmas trees at the City compost site at 800 W. 8th Street.

The City will NOT collect or remove trees, shrubs or branches that are routinely cut or trimmed by property owners or assigns. This is the responsibility of the property owner.

Fall Leaf Pickup

In the fall, the public works crew vacuums leaves from the boulevards in residential areas of the City. This is a time consuming procedure, and is weather dependent. The crew tries to cover the entire City two times. This takes approximately 6-8 week to complete, and continues until all leaves have been picked up, or the leaves are covered in snow. Check the City of Neillsville Facebook page for updates on where the crews are working.

Leaves will be vacuumed only from the boulevard, not raked clean. Leaves must be placed within 8 feet of the curb edge.

Do NOT rake leaves into the street.
