

SEWER RATES EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2025

CATEGORY A: Those sanitary sewer users who discharge normal domestic strength wastewater with concentrations of BOD no greater than 271 mg/l, suspended solids no greater than 265 mg/l, or phosphorus no greater than 10 mg/l.

Fixed Quarterly Charge: \$12.62                      Volume Charge: \$10.10 per 100 cubic feet

CATEGORY B: Those sanitary sewer users who discharge wastewater with concentrations in excess of 271 mg/l for BOD, 265 mg/l for suspended solids, or 10 mg/l for phosphorus.

Fixed Quarterly Charge: \$12.62                      Volume Charge: \$10.10 per 100 cubic feet

Surcharge:                      BOD (greater than 271mg/l)                      \$ 1.87lb  
    Suspended Solids (greater than 265 mg/l)                      \$ 1.21lb  
    Phosphorus (greater than 10mg/l)                      \$17.00lb

HAULER CHARGE PER TRIP: \$29.16 plus HOLDING TANK CHARGE: \$11.96 per 100 cubic feet, or  
SEPTIC TANK CHARGE: \$81.14 per 100 cubic feet

Billing: Bills for sewer service are rendered quarterly and become due and payable on the first of the month following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of 3%, but not less than 50 cents will be added to bills not paid within 20 days of issuance. This late payment charge is applicable to all customers.

GENERAL SEWER SERVICE – UNMETERED: Service shall be billed at the rate of \$113.62. This rate shall be applied only to single-family residential customers and approximates the cost for 1,000 cubic feet per quarter discharged to the sewer system.
