Billing: Bills for sewer service are rendered quarterly and become due and payable on the first of the month following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of 3%, but not less than 50 cents will be added to bills not paid within <u>20 days</u> of issuance. This late payment charge is applicable to all customers.

<u>GENERAL SEWER SERVICE – UNMETERED</u>: Service shall be billed at the rate of \$113.62. This rate shall be applied only to single-family residential customers and approximates the cost for 1,000 cubic feet per quarter discharged to the sewer system.
